The cocaine cowboys of the '80s are gone, but Miami's Casablanca allure, the undercover cops and the attitudes of Michael Mann's influential television series have been enhanced by time in the feature film version of **MIAMI VICE**.

Ricardo Tubbs (Academy Award® winner Jamie Foxx of Ray, Jarhead) is urbane and dead smart. He lives with intel analyst Trudy (Naomane Harris of 28 Days Later; Pirates of the Caribbean II and III), as they work undercover transporting drug loads into South Florida to identify a group responsible for three murders. Sony Crockett (Colin Farrell of S.W.A.T.: The New World), may seem unorthodox to the untrained eye, but his results are sound. Charming and flirtatious, he gets romantically entangled with Isabella (Gong Li of Raise the Red Lantern, Memoirs of a Geisha), the Chinese-Cuban wife of an arms and drugs trafficker.

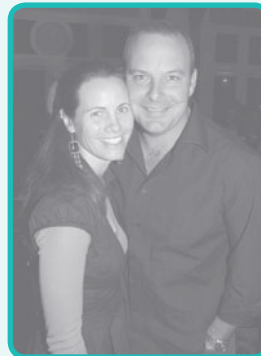
